## Kindergarten

- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- 2 bottles of hand sanitizer
- 2 box of wipes
- 12 glue sticks
- 24 pencils (primary size or #2 lead)
- 2 boxes of (8) count crayons
- 1 box of (8) count markers
- 1 pair of fiskars scissors
- 2 boxes of expo markers (1 box is for art)
- 1 box of gallon size Ziploc bags
- 1 box of quart size Ziploc bags
- 1 box of snack size Ziploc bags
- 1 full size back pack (no wheels)
- 2 Folders (without prongs)
- 1 Folder (with prongs)

## First Grade—Supplies are for shared use.

- 4 packs of pencils- No. 2 presharpener, yellow only
- 1 pack of 3 or 5 – Expo-dry erase chisel point marker - low odor- black
- 2 boxes of Crayola Crayons- 16 count
- 1 spiral notebook- Kirby, Smith only (Please write name on notebooks.)
- 8 glue sticks (Kirby—2 packs)
- 2 pink pearl erasers
- 1 pair of “Fiskar scissors (Smith only)
- 1 book bag – no wheels
- 4 Boxes of Kleenex
- 1 hand sanitizer-pump size- Girls will bring this.
- 2 Boxes of baby wipes- Boys will bring this.
- 1 box of gallon size zip-lock bags
- 2 boxes of sandwich size zip-lock bags
- 2 2-pocket plain folders (front & Back) - 1 red & 1 Blue Coleman Only:
  - 1- black and white composition notebook-hardback
  - 1 Pack magic markers

- 3 marbled composition notebooks (**no spiral notebooks**)

- Ziploc Bags (gallon size and sandwich size)

### Third Grade

- Box of tissues

### Fourth Grade
