In order to conduct official business at a regular or special meeting, a quorum of the board must be present.

A quorum is defined as one more than half of the members of the board. If a quorum is not present at any meetings, the chairperson will postpone the meetings until such time as a quorum can be present, provided adequate notice is given pursuant to the Open Meetings Law. Proxy voting will not be recognized by the board.
