These services are a core component of the free and appropriate public education provided for all students.

Psychological services include assessment, intervention, consultation, and professional development. Referrals for assessment services come through schools' Student Assistance Teams and required Exceptional Children's Program processes. Referrals for other services may come from family members or community resources/agencies that have a specific concern or an interest in a student's well-being. All services are provided in a non-discriminatory manner. All information that is shared in these helping relationships is confidential.
