Productive working relationships with governmental agencies are critical to the school district efforts to provide safe, orderly and inviting learning environments. These relationships also are important for coordinating services so that all of the needs of children can be met by the various agencies in an efficient and effective manner.

The Board will cooperate fully with County Civil Defense/American Red Cross authorities in all emergencies. The superintendent is authorized to make available facilities and commodities of the school system upon the request of the Director of Civil Defense. District personnel shall also work with Civil Defense/American Red Cross authorities in developing an Emergency plan for the schools and providing necessary training and instruction to implement the plan.

It is understood that the school district will be reimbursed for any damage incurred or commodities used.

All administrators are expected to promote and maintain productive working relationships with other governmental agencies. Any contracts or specific agreements regarding working relationships with other governmental agencies must be approved by the board.
