The Board shall provide bus transportation for students enrolled in the Orange County School system in keeping with requirements of state law and State Board of Education regulations. Provisions for bus transportation is not a duty required of the Board; thus school bus transportation is considered a privilege, not a right and the transportation of any student is subject to compliance with lawful rules and regulations adopted by the Board. All bus riders are to abide by the rules and regulations adopted for bus transportation. Students not obeying such regulations may be denied the privilege of riding school buses.

The Superintendent shall have overall responsibility for the supervision of bus transportation and shall see that appropriate state laws and State Board of Education regulation are enforced.

The Bus Driver Manager and the Director of Transportation are responsible for the supervision of drivers. The Bus Driver Manager and the TIMS Data Coordinator are responsible for the assignment of students, routing school buses and setting up bus stops. Administrative and support services shall be annually billed on a pro rata proportionate use basis.
