It shall be the policy of the Board to seek the construction of a sufficient number of school buildings to meet the demands of present and future student enrollment and, in doing so, to provide the highest type of education environment for students at the lowest expenditure of tax dollars.

Decisions pertaining to the construction of education facilities will be made only after an attempt has been made to carefully consider the viewpoints and needs of students, teachers, and other taxpayers.

Architects employed by the Board are expected to plan for simplicity of design; sound economics, including low long-range maintenance costs and low insurance rates; energy efficiency; high educational utility; flexibility; and compliance with DOCC School construction requirements.

The architect will be responsible for making certain that all local, state and federal codes, covenants and restrictions and inspections are met.
