As a general policy, the Board accepts the following regarding the location of school sites:

1. School sites should be located as near as is practical to the center of the attendance area they are expected to serve.
2. Elementary school sites should not be located adjacent to major arterial streets or highways. Insofar as possible, sites should be located in neighborhoods or potential neighborhoods, which are not divided, by major arterial streets or highways.
3. Junior and senior high sites should not be located adjacent to major arterial streets or highways. However, such sites should be located to permit ready access by automobile from major arterials.
4. It is desirable for school sites to be located in such a way as to facilitate joint use of the sites and adjacent parks and playgrounds by both the schools and the county recreational department.
